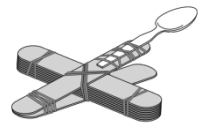
Tuesdays: Craft Kitchen – Grades K-5 3:05-4:05pm

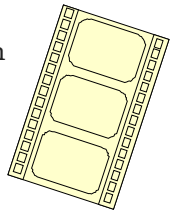
